- Do not modify the cargo organizer.
- Do not install the cargo organizer in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in doubt, please contact your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- Your cargo organizer is designed to transport normal cargo contents. Flammable or dangerous materials should not be transported in your vehicle at any time. If any corrosive chemicals are spilled on your cargo organizer, it should be cleaned as described in the Care and Cleaning section.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.
- Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.
- To ensure safety and reliability of the work, installation, removal and disposal work must be carried out by an Authorized Mazda Dealership.
- Be careful not to lose removed parts, and be sure that they are kept free of dirt, scratches, or damage.





3. BEFORE INSTALLATION

! WARNING

Before performing any work, park the vehicle on level ground, apply the parking brake securely, and then block the wheels. If the vehicle moves while performing work, it may cause injury.



CARE & CLEANING

- When cleaning the cargo organizer, use warm water or diluted mild detergent.
- Never use any organic solvent such as thinner or benzene.
- Rinse cargo organizer thoroughly with water and allow it to dry before reinstalling.
- When not using the cargo organizer, wash with water and dry it completely before storing it on a flat surface. To prevent deformation when storing, do not place any heavy object on top of the organizer.

4. CARGO ORGANIZER INSTALLATION

- Cargo area should be dry and clear of debris before attempting installation.




1. Open rear liftgate.



2. Fold rearward portion of cargo floor board upward.



3. Fold middle and rearward portions of cargo floor board upward, exposing middle cargo sub-compartment.



4. Place cargo organizer on cargo sub-compartment tray, with flat foward wall of cargo organizer facing toward front of vehicle.



5. Insert cargo organizer into middle cargo sub-compartment, ensuring it is fully seated.



6. Unfold cargo floor board until flat and fully covering cargo sub-compartments.
